## Landscaping Tips for April:

- It is a good time to transplant or plant new trees and shrubs.
- April 15<sup>th</sup> is typically considered the last threat of frost. Depending on weather conditions, you should start running your irrigation system around this time.
- Water newly installed plant material and lawns. Watering should be done evenly and thoroughly if there is no significant rainfall.
