Irrigation Watering Tips To Help Your Lawn:

- 1) Adapt your watering schedule to the weather and the season.
- 2) Familiarize yourself with the settings on your system so you are able to tell if it is not running correctly or if the settings need to be changed.
- 3) Water only when needed, watering too much and too frequently results in shallow roots, weed growth and diseases.
- 4) Water after sunset and before sunrise when winds are calm and temperatures are a little cooler. This will help reduce evaporation.
- 5) Install a rain shutoff switch, they are inexpensive and effective. Required by law in many states, these money-saving sensors turn off your system in rainy weather and help to compensate for natural rainfall. Please feel free to call with any questions about this product, 856-783-8833 x 16.
