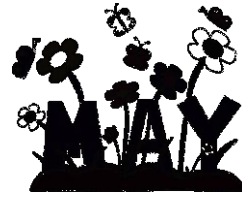

Landscaping Updates for May

May is typically the time when the weather starts to really warm-up. When this happens, your landscaping may start to change drastically. If you do not have your irrigation system started up yet, after a few hot days in a row, your lawn will start to burn. Make sure you have your irrigation turned on in time!

Those dandelions that you saw popping up at the end of April will quickly turn to seed heads. Step 2 of our Lawn Care program will have get rid of both dandelions and seed heads.
