New mulch and plantings can make a huge difference at a cost you can afford!

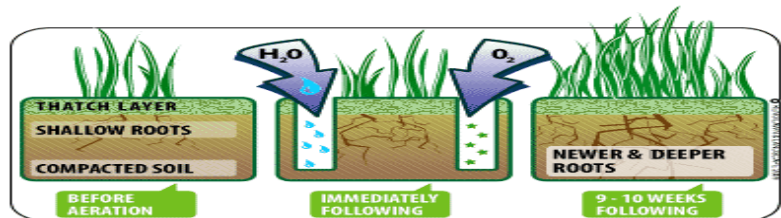
September Checklist:
